

GROUND FLOOR PLAN





AND ITS HISTORY

A project by Cogir Real Estate in partnership with CREECO, a premiere in Canada, this project, named Odea, is based on the Cree word «ode» meaning canoe, which is responsible for the subtle and stylized representation of the canoe in the architecture. Located at the beginning of the downtown core, the Odea project aims to highlight the presence of the Cree Nation in Montreal through a distinctive project, integrating its values and certain elements of its culture. The architectural concept creates a visual and urban link between the project and its environment. The design approach reveals the unique character of the project while ensuring its urban integration. This highly symbolic building includes office spaces, as well as commercial and residential spaces with 367 apartments and 68 condos. The construction also has a basilica, a 25-storey tower and an interior courtyard that will be accessible to the public. Two heritage buildings on the site will be preserved and integrated into the construction.


